



The only way is local

At Thornham Deli we have made a commitment to stock as much local produce as possible. This extends from fruit and vegetables, such as the famous Sharrington Strawberries and Asparagus, through to locally-caught and smoked fish from Staithe Smokehouse.

The cheeses and charcuterie on our deli counter reflect Norfolk's growing reputation as a major force on the foodie scene and our menu is full of local produce that Executive Head Chef Gemma Arnold and her kitchen team have turned into culinary masterpieces.

But serving up locally produced treats isn't just a marketing trend. It makes good economic sense and it can even contribute to a wider healthy eating movement. Here's why:

Food that travels fewer miles is higher quality

Once a product is separated from its source – picked, harvested, dug-up – it's nutritional value starts to deteriorate. Whatever the packaging, the product will lose moisture in transit and there is potential microbial spoilage. Many foods that have travelled long distances have been sprayed with chemicals to withstand the commute from field to fork.

Eat seasonally to match your body's rhythms

Farmers and growers can only work with the seasons. However, nature is a clever thing and our bodies are

designed to eat seasonal food that supports our health. Building a lifestyle around seasonal food supports the body's natural healing processes. Leafy greens, abundant in spring, help our bodies detox after a winter of heavier foods. While in summer, water-dense fruits like berries keep us hydrated. Once again, Mother Nature shows she knows best.

Invest in your community and the environment

By shopping locally you keep money in your area, which helps to sustain local producers and create local jobs. And, by supporting your local farmer today, you'll help ensure that there will be farms in your community tomorrow. This is vital for our long-term food security, especially with an uncertain energy future and our current reliance on fossil fuels to produce, package, transport and store food.

At the same time, buying locally can help reduce our impact on the environment. Choosing to buy your food from local sources eliminates the need for fuel-intensive transportation. Where possible, select farmers who follow organic and sustainable farming practices to minimise the environmental impact of your food.



Going wild in the countryside

Things have been stirring in the Norfolk countryside in the past two years. Where once deer and rabbits were the most exotic sightings, now this is the county of Great Bustards, Beavers, Bongos and White Tailed Eagles.

Two new visitor attractions have opened recently, both offering versions of how the landscape could look were it to be rewarded – or left to nature.



More than 20 types of ungulate and rare bird species have been given a safe haven at the reserve in which to flourish. Among the new residents are the shy but stunning Bongo, Malayan Sambar, Barasingha, Hog deer and the almost extinct Père David's Deer. Ed and his wife and business partner Anna also harbour hopes of

reintroducing the Great Busted (pictured above) to roam naturally in Norfolk, nearly 200 years after it was hunted to extinction in the county. They currently have two males and a clutch of females within the reserve.

Although the reserve is primarily a conservation and breeding centre, it is now open to the public with both on-site accommodation and day visits complete with sat-nav guided electric buggies. There is a variety of accommodation, including Major's Lodge, a neat wooden safari lodge, which is positioned so that guests have quite awe-inspiring views across the reserve.

Watatunga is a nature reserve and conservation centre in Watlington, five miles outside King's Lynn. It is set within 170 acres of disused quarry, sub-standard agricultural land, woodland and grassland. There are lakes where there used to be diggers and open fields with swathes of wild flowers and grasses where there used to be monoculture crops such as sugar beet and barley.

The name is a mash-up of Watlington and sitatunga – a type of African antelope – and has been a life-time in the making. Owner and architect of the reserve is Ed Pope, a farmer with a conservationist's heart. "I used to spend hours with my dad in bird hides watching the wild ducks," he says. Family visits to Africa further whet the appetite for working with endangered species and within the wider realms of conservation.

Wild Ken Hill can be found just outside Snettisham, bordering the Wash. It is 1,040 acres of farm land – comprising lowland, mixed woodland, heathlands and meadow – that is now being managed with the lightest of touches. The main objective of the the team at Wild Ken Hill is to allow nature to thrive and, in the process,

help tackle climate change and improve air and water quality.

The project has divided into three main approaches - a rewilding area, where beavers and grazers, such as Red Poll cattle and Exmoor ponies, are being introduced, a traditional conservation approach for their coastal areas, and regenerative farming to continue to provide food in a sustainable and biodiverse way.

Themed guided tours, including Nature by Night, Dusk on the Marsh and Rewilding in Practice, offer visitors both a visually exciting and sensory experience as well as providing an

amazing insight into this visionary project. There are also workshops and volunteering opportunities for people who, literally, get bitten by the bug!



Designed by Skipper the building is described by Pevsner as "a milestone in the English Arts and Craft Movement".


